About Rishikesh

Rishikesh is a city in India's northern state of Uttarakhand in the Himalayan foothills beside the Ganges River. The river is considered holy and the city is renowned as a centre for studying yoga and meditation. Temples and ashrams line the eastern bank of Ganges. Apart from spirituality and adventure, now Rishikesh is also a hub for scientific activities.

Eligibility Criteria

This competition is open to all young biomedical researchers (UG, PG, PhD & Research Scholars who are not above the age of 35 years as on 15th October). Faculty & Industrial Delegates.

The abstract submission date for the oral & poster competition will be closed one month before the competition date

Abstract should be structured in four headings (Background, Materials & Methods, Results, Conclusion) with maximum 250 words

Abstract has to be submitted through online web portal (www.nbrcom.sybsindia.org / www.sybsindia.org)
Shortlisted abstracts for the competition will be intimated through email.

This is an opportunity for young researchers to learn about the research areas of their peers so as to increase their capability as multidisciplinary researchers.

All shortlisted oral & poster presenters have to be registered before the deadline of abstract submission.

Evaluation Criteria

When the competition is being conducted, each participant should be ready in front of his/her poster to answer all questions from the judges.

You will be given about 5-7 minutes to present your poster & 10 minutes for oral presentation including questions during the evaluation.

Judges will evaluate the quality and content of research work student's enthusiasm towards their study, interest and knowledge in the area of their research.

The winners will be announced at the closing ceremony of the competition.
